



To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Clarence S. Shank, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Saginaw, in the county of Saginaw and State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Dairy Bar, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a dairy bar, showing my new design, both sides being exactly the same;

Fig. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; and Fig. 3 is a rear elevational view.
